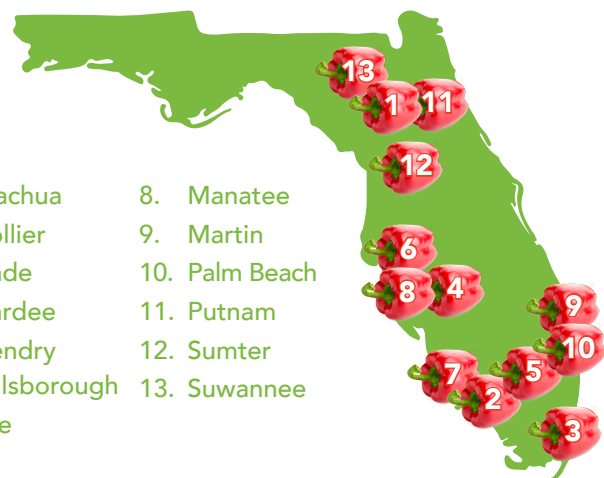
Bell peppers in Florida come in a variety of colors, including: red, yellow, orange, green, purple, white and brown!

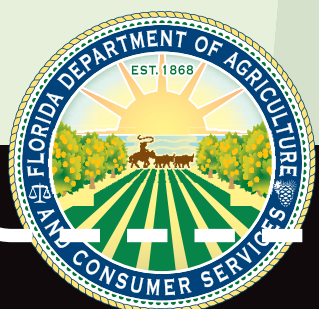
Florida bell peppers are primarily grown south of Orlando, in Palm Beach, Hendry, Collier and Manatee counties, as well as:
